Position Summary: The LaSOR Project Manager is responsible for supporting the

implementation of the Louisiana State Opioid Response Program (LaSOR). This position will co-lead the day-to-day program coordination and management activities, which will include working to strengthen and expand substance use disorder/opioid use disorder prevention, treatment, and recovery services to enhance rural Louisiana residents' ability to

access treatment and move towards recovery.

Responsibilities

- 1. Coordinate activities of the RCORP coalition, which contributes to the overall strategic direction and implementation of program activities.
- 2. Write and lead implementation plan in collaboration with senior leadership and subject matter experts to ensure compliance of program requirements.
- 3. Direct, manage and execute ongoing, statewide project activities.
- 4. Serve as subject matter expert and/or fill technical roles on related projects.
- 5. Recruit and maintain a diverse coalition membership with state and national partners.
- 6. Plan and coordinate coalition meetings and meeting activities.
